Why attend?

Presentations by the MAHC Technical Review Committee on the key proposed changes to the Model Aquatic Health Code will include their assessments, a review of supporting documentation, potential improvements and a summary of submitted CMAHC Member comments and recommendations. There will be multiple opportunities for caucusing and discussing the Change Requests. Voting by CMAHC Members will begin one month following the conference. The CMAHC is your direct conduit to advise the CDC on the MAHC and the future of aquatic regulations.

We will also hear from Doug Sackett, Executive Director of CMAHC and Michael Beach, President of the CMAHC Board of Directors.

We invite Member comment for any proposed CR changes.

- We will include summaries of member comments received by Wednesday, September 30.
- We will continue to accept comments through October 23 so you can reflect on the Conference CR discussion and still have the opportunity to suggest improvements for two weeks after it ends. Actual voting will start one month after the Conference ends.
